Conditions of Entry

Work to be hung

1. Up to eight works may be submitted. Entries may be from any of the following categories:-

- Painting and drawing (any media)
- Photography
- Textiles (2 dimensional)
- Printmaking
- Sculpture

All work to be hung must have hanging eyelets on both sides to take a picture cord.

1. One piece of work is *guaranteed* to be hung. Others will be exhibited depending upon available hanging space. Unhung work will be kept in reserve and utilised as and when replacements are required during the exhibition.
2. Each item submitted will incur a **£1 non-refundable entry fee**.
3. A commission of 20% will be deducted from the sale price of all works sold.
Please note that not all work has to be for sale.

Mounted pictures and cards

1. There is no limit to the number of works that may be submitted.
2. Please ensure all items on paper are suitably protected ie. wrapped in cellophane.
3. No entry fee will be charged.
4. A commission of **20%** will be deducted from the sale price of all works sold.
5. **All** work submitted in this category should be for sale.

General

1. **All** work should be submitted with a label on the reverse detailing the **Title, Name and Address of the Artist, and the Price**. Items that are not for sale should make it clear on the label. **Donations of work** are also welcome and should be identified as such at submission. The total sale price of donated work will be retained (see 4 below).
2. Submissions should be original works only and are limited to residents of **Littleham and Landcross and members of the Littleham Art Group**.
3. **Work should be submitted between 10.00 and 12.00 on Tuesday June 21st.** (anyone unable to deliver at this time please contact **Pat Haddrell** on **01237 421341** or **Robert Reed** on **01237 475716** before the time). Work cannot be submitted after this time unless by arrangement.
4. Funds raised from the exhibition are to be used for Village Projects.
5. Contributing artists are invited to attend the Private View at the Village Hall on **Thursday June 23 between 17.30 and 19.00**. An invitation for this will be issued at time of submission.
6. Work will be available for collection on **Monday June 27th, between 10.00 and 12.00**.

Please remember to invite your friends to the exhibition! It will open to the public on **Friday June 24, 10.00-16.00; Saturday June 25, 10-18.00 and Sunday June 26, 10.00-15.00**
