- 2. To register, you need to complete an entry form and pay a £2 registration fee
- 3. The entry form can be downloaded from www.littleham-landcross.org.uk or collected from either of the addresses below
- 4. Your completed entry form and £2 fee should be returned to one or other of the two addresses below by Wednesday, 1st June
- 5. The Scarecrow or Group of Scarecrows must be named
- 6. Scarecrows must be clearly visible from the road and will need to be weather-proof.
- 7. If you wish to display your scarecrow at a site outside the village hall, instead of outside your house, please tick the relevant box on the entry form.
- 8. Entries need to be on display from the 11th until at least the 26th June
- 9. Scarecrows will be judged between 11th and 18th June
- 10. The winning scarecrows will be announced at 2 p.m. on 26th June at The Art Exhibition at the Village Hall
- 11. There will be a cash prize for the best scarecrow in each category
- 12. Credit will be given for interest, originality and attention to detail.
- 13. Photos of all entries will be on display at the Village Hall during the Art Exhibition from 24th 26th June
- 14.Results and photos of the winning entries will be displayed on the website and printed in the Crosslet
