

**LITTLEHAM & LANDCROSS PARISH COUNCIL**  
**MINUTES OF AN URGENT PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT**  
**LITTLEHAM VILLAGE HALL ON THURSDAY 11 DECEMBER 2008**

**786 Planning Application: 1/1134/2008/FUL; Additional window at Sealocks Barn, Landcross:**  
**RESOLVED**, on the motion of Cllr Mrs Beer, seconded by Cllr G Smith, that Planning Application 1/1134/2008/FUL is recommended for APPROVAL.

**787 Highways & Footpaths; Matters arising from Minute 778:**

**(a) Upadown Lane, Littleham:**

The Chairman read out a letter from Mrs Alison Smith, DCC Definitive Footpath Map Officer, advising that she had looked at this route during the review of rights of way in Littleham, when the route was suggested as a possible right of way, but she had only received three user evidence forms from walkers who had used this route on foot, one for over 20 years and the other two for much less time. An appeal for more users to come forward in the parish's public consultation stage had been posted on Littleham Village Public Notice Board. The process to add rights of way to the Definitive Map is evidence based. Mrs Smith suggests that the Parish Council should consider making a dedication agreement with the landowner concerned, to add this route to the Definitive Map.

**RESOLVED**, that receipt of the letter is noted and that the Parish Council considers suitable action at their next main meeting.

**(b) Mud on Wagon Road:**

A letter from Mr Elsworthy, DCC, reported that he had checked Wagon Road on the 28th November. He advised that a reasonable attempt had been made at keeping the road clean and it looked like the road had been washed. Therefore no further action will be taken by DCC this time.

**RESOLVED**, that the Parish Council sends a letter to Mr Withecombe to thank him for his prompt attention to their complaint.
