Cllr Hamilton Proposed that this Outline Application be Approved with the following comments and conditions:

- The Design and Access Document from the Applicant states "and the village itself, through the parish council, have expressed a desire for more dwellings" this is incorrect the Parish Council have not expressed/recorded this fact.
- The position of the front walls of the property result in a widening of the road such that 2 vehicles can easily pass
- The new field gate entrance should be constructed in a manner which gives traffic a good view of any emerging traffic/animals.
